



PRAYER FOR ILLUMINATION


In preparation to receive God's Word, we light the Christ candle and pray for illumination from God's word. Take a moment for silent reflection.



Lord's Prayer

Gathered into one by the Spirit, let us pray as Jesus taught us:



Communion Distribution

Receive the bread with open hands, and receive either the wine (red liquid) or juice (clear liquid). If you do not desire to receive communion, you are welcome to come forward for a blessing. Simply cross your arms over your chest as an indication to the server.

The altar is stripped as psalms are read. The Christ candle, representing Christ's present in our midst, is carried out last as a representation of his arrest by the Roman guard.

We depart in silence, gathering again tomorrow at the trial and cross of Jesus.
