Water is poured into the font. After each petition, the congregation responds to "Baptized into you, O Living One" with "Make us one as you are one."





In preparation to receive God's Word, we light the Christ candle and pray for illumination from God's word. Take a moment for silent reflection.


Readings: Acts 1:1-11; Psalm 47; Ephesians 1:15-23





Gathered into one by the Spirit, let us pray as Jesus taught us:


