Baptized into Christ's death and resurrection, and called to live the baptized life, let us give thanks for the gifts of baptism.


Water is poured into the font. After each petition, the congregation responds to "Baptized into you, O Living One" with **"Make us one as you are one."**



Lord's Prayer

Gathered into one by the Spirit, let us pray as Jesus taught us:


